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For the above reason, we are happy to share the tracks with you, hoping that you can have fun in our territory, but we won't responsible for the use that you are going to do, as no one has forced you to walk or ride on this track.

If from Montaione, we take "Via XVIII Luglio", a steep descent will take us up into the valley of the river "Egola" and after having made some fords, it is worth making a short detour to reach the "Pozzo Sfondato".

In this fascinating and wild place there is an old brick bridge over the "Egola" creek. The stream flows on the rocks forming small waterfalls and digging real wells or holes where, on hot summer days, inhabitants of Montaione still go to cool off. From the valley of the "Egola" creek we climb up to enter Via Cerroni until we reach San Vivaldo.

We climb on Via Ecce Homo and take the left path with many uphills and downhills through the woods back to the valley with a peculiar and very steep final stretch to the "Egola".

After crossing the creek and the crystal clear waters running through the rocks and stones, we get to the paved road back to Montaione.


